PLS - Paediatric Life Support

Aims/Purpose:

The 1 day PLS course is based on the systematic approach taught on the Advanced Paediatric Life Support (3 day) course, and APLS NZ has established programme with course material. The focus of the course is on the management of the severely ill or injured child in the first 15 minutes of care.

Content:

Basic Life Support, intraosseous access, airway management of a baby and child, recognition of a seriously ill child, human factors and teamwork in resuscitation, rhythm recognition and defibrillation. There are scenarios to participate in and testing stations on basic life support and airway management.
