Priorities of Clinical Educator – Intravenous & Related Therapies

- The role is responsible for ensuring attainment and maintenance of standards in intravenous and related therapies by enhancing workforce competence and capability across Hutt Valley DHB. This is achieved through developing, implementing and evaluating training and/or education programmes and training resources.
- Linking with ward/unit based educators and managers the Clinical Educator (IV&RT) seeks to improve the capability and effectiveness of the role across the DHBs, meeting individual service needs as required.
- The Clinical Educator (IV&RT) also takes a lead role in developing and/or delivering policies and education programmes that enable patients/clients to be managed by health care practitioners within the community/primary care setting in partnership with the Nursing Director Primary Health and Integrated Care.
- This role links in with equivalent roles across the sub-region and Central Region to ensure a consistent approach to the delivery of education and implementation of practice standards.
