Workplace assessor training is designed to train assessors who need to evaluate performance against standards in a variety of clinical and non-clinical settings. On completion participants will have increased understanding of all the factors that contribute to the successful completion of an assessment.

NOTE: Assessors must also hold the relevant competencies in order to assess the specific skill e.g. must be IV competent in order to assess another nurses IV competence. This course is relevant to those undertaking performance appraisals, a variety of clinical skills assessments, PDRP and portfolio assessments and other situations where assessment of another person's performance is required.
