Thank you for your request dated 20 December 2018 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982, regarding funding amounts allocated for brief intervention counselling initiatives. You requested:

*“How much funding does your District Health Board receive or allocate directly or through Primary Health Organisations for Brief Intervention Counselling (BIC) initiatives?”*

The information pertaining to your request is below.

The Hutt Valley District Health Board does not explicitly receive funding or fund services called Brief Intervention Counselling. However, we do fund primary mental health services through our PHO (Te Awakairangi Health Network) and VIBE Youth Health Services (Hutt Valley Youth Health Trust), which have components of brief interventions to them.
