Staff update 29 June 2022



Building options on the Hutt Hospital site are required in order to vacate the Heretaunga building in a way that maximises service continuity, for our patients, staff and communities.

DESIGNING A PREFABRICATED BUILDING

Preliminary options are being developed for a prefabricated building to be constructed at Hutt Hospital to facilitate vacating the Heretaunga building as the fastest way to provide on-site inpatient capacity. These options will require other service location and model of care changes as they will not have the capacity to fully replace the Heretaunga building.

Destravis will be hosting workshops with our District Clinical Advisory Group and senior managers next week to look at how we arrange some services into prefabricated buildings which will be a temporary solution while master site planning and development occurs.

Hutt services have been contributing ideas and thoughts about how they could be reconfigured to allow for decant options.

Following the Destravis workshops, integrated workshops across our district will occur with clinical and management representation to contribute to deeper clinical service design.

A staged business case will then be developed to enable new service design and decanting to occur.
